19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-18-503(b) is hereby amended to  
22 read as follows:

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

1 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2

3       SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9       SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
10 hereby repealed.

11

12       SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the  
13 Eightieth General Assembly that there is some confusion in the various school  
14 districts of this state as to procedures for administering corporal  
15 punishment, as set forth in Act 51 of the Second Extraordinary Session of  
16 1994 and that immediate implementation of this act is necessary to clarify  
17 these procedures. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and  
18 this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
19 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and  
20 approval.
