8 "AN ACT TO REPEAL AN OBSOLETE PROVISION OF THE ARKANSAS  
9 CODE WHICH REQUIRES COUNTY TREASURERS IN COUNTIES WITH TWO  
10 COUNTY SEATS TO KEEP IN THEIR OFFICE AT EACH COUNTY SEAT  
11 THE FUNDS BELONGING TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND ROAD  
12 DISTRICTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## 14 Subtitle

15 "REPEAL OBSOLETE PROVISIONS OF THE ARK.  
16 CODE REQUIRING COUNTY TREASURERS IN  
17 COUNTIES WITH TWO COUNTY SEATS TO KEEP  
18 IN THEIR OFFICE FUNDS BELONGING TO  
19 SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND ROAD DISTRICTS."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas 14-15-803 is hereby repealed.

25 SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly  
26 that Arkansas Code 14-15-803 provides that the treasurer of each county  
27 having two judicial districts (with the exception of certain counties) must  
28 keep in their office at each county seat the funds belonging to the school  
29 districts and road districts of the respective judicial districts; that such  
30 provision is obsolete and unduly burdensome upon those county treasurers; and  
31 this act should immediately go into effect to eliminate that burden.  
32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being  
33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and  
35 approval.
