9 MILITARY LEAVE OF ABSENCE PROVISIONS; AND FOR OTHER

13 "TO CLARIFY MILITARY LEAVE OF ABSENCE
14 PROVISIONS."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 21-4-102(a) is amended to read as follows:
19 "(a) All employees of the state, as defined in § 21-4-203, who desire
20 to take a leave of absence for the purpose of participating in the military
21 training programs made available by the National Guard or any of the reserve
22 branches of the armed forces and all state employees who are members of the
23 Reserve Corps of the Public Health Service who desire to take a leave of
24 absence for the purpose of participating in the civil defense and public
25 health training programs made available by the United States Public Health
26 Service shall be entitled to such a leave of absence for a period of fifteen
27 (15) days plus necessary travel time for annual training requirements or
28 other duties performed in an official duty status in any one (1) calendar
29 year. To the extent this leave is not used in a calendar year, it will
30 accumulate for use in the succeeding calendar year until it totals fifteen
31 (15) days at the beginning of the calendar year."

33 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 21-4-102(e) is hereby repealed.

34

35 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent

1 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
2 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
