## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARK. CODE §§ 6-11-101 THROUGH 6-11-103
AND §§ 25-6-101 AND 25-6-102 TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE STATE BOARD OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION SHALL BE COMPRISED OF THE SAME MEMBERS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

"TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE BOARDS OF EDUCATION AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION SHALL BE COMPRISED OF THE SAME MEMBERS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-11-101 is hereby amended to read as follows:
"6-11-101. Members.
(a) The State Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education each shall be composed of the same twelve (12) members, two (2) to be selected from each congressional district of the state and the remainder to be appointed at large from within the state.
(b) The term of office of a member of the State Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education shall be six (6) years.
(c) The membership of the boards shall be reflective of the diversity in general education and vocational education.
(d)(l) No person may serve as a member of the boards unless he is a qualified elector and is a person of high moral standards and recognized ability.
(2) No candidate for public office, holder of a public office in
the state, school teacher, the Director of General Education, the Director of Vocational Education, county or city superintendent, employee of a state-supported college or university, nor member of any board of trustees of any state institution of higher learning shall serve as a member of the State Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education.
(e) The members of the State Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education shall be appointed by the Governor, subject to the confirmation of the Senate, and shall take the oath of office prescribed by the Constitution for officers.
(f)(1) When a vacancy occurs in the membership of the boards, the Governor shall appoint a successor to the person who has vacated the membership, who will serve the unexpired term of the person succeeded, subject to all other provisions of this act.
(2) Resignation, removal from the district from which he is appointed, disqualification, incapacitation from mental or physical disability or otherwise, or change in status from the eligibility requirements for membership on the boards shall automatically create a vacancy in the membership held by a member of the boards, and no such member shall thereafter exercise any of the functions of membership on the boards even though his successor has not been appointed.
(g) Members of the boards shall be subject to removal from office by the Governor when the actions or conditions of a member shall be considered as sufficient cause for removal. However, before a member may be removed for cause, this cause must have been accepted as true, good, and sufficient by a majority written vote of all members of the boards after a formal hearing at a regular or special session of the boards.
(h) The members of the State Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education shall serve without remuneration other than:
(1) Their actual expenses while attending regular and special meetings of the boards; and
(2) A per diem allowance when in attendance at regular or special meetings of the boards.
(i) The members of the State Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education shall be cognizant at all times of educational issues that cross the lines of authority and responsibilty of the General Education

Division and the Vocational and Technical Education Division. Such issues shall be brought to the attention of the chairman so that he may schedule the issue for action at a meeting of either board but with the Director of the General Education Division and the Director of the Vocational and Technical Education Division both present at the meeting in their capacity as ex officio secretary of their respective board. Action taken by the board regarding such issue shall be binding on both the General Education Division and the Vocational and Technical Education Division.
(j) Upon the effective date of this act, those members of the State Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education shall become members of the two (2) boards, along with those persons additionally appointed by the Governor as prescribed by this section, so as to complete the composition of the boards. At the first meeting of the boards, the members shall draw lots for terms of office, with the terms of two (2) members expiring on June 30, 1996, and no more than two (2) terms expiring on June 30 of each year thereafter."

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-11-102 is hereby amended to read as follows:
"6-11-102. Directors - General Education - Vocational and Technical Education.
(a) Subject to confirmation by the Governor, the State Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education are empowered to employ persons to act as the Director of General Education and the Director of Vocational and Technical Education, who shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
(b) The directors shall devote all of their time to the duties of their offices, shall act as agents of the boards, and perform such other duties as are designated by the boards or by statute.
(c)(l) The person selected as the Director of General Education must:
(A) Be a person of good moral character, recognized as a leader in the field of education, qualified technically and by experience to direct the work of the Department of Education;
(B) Hold the master's degree from an accredited

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institution;
(C) Have had ten (10) years' experience as a teacher, five (5) of which must be of an administrative or supervisory nature; and
(D) Hold a valid state teacher's certificate.
(2) No person who is related within the fourth degree of consanguinity or affinity to any member of the State Board of Education shall be eligible to serve as Director of the General Education Division.
(d)(1) The person selected as Director of the Vocational and Technical Education Division must:
(A) Be a person of good moral character, recognized as a leader in the field of vocational education, qualified technically and by experience to direct the work of the Vocational and Technical Education Division;
(B) Hold the master's degree from an accredited institution;
(C) Have had ten (10) years' experience as a teacher, supervisor, and administrator of vocational education with the experience representing positions of increasing responsibility; and
(D) Qualify as a teacher in a vocational program area under the state board's standard qualification requirements.
(2) No person who is related within the fourth degree of consanguinity or affinity to any member of the State Board of Vocational Education shall be eligible to serve as Director of Vocational and Technical Education.
(e) It is the specific intention of this act to define and declare the Director of General Education to be the employee of the State Board of Education and the Director of Vocational and Technical Education to be the employee of the State Board of Vocational Education.
(f)(l) The Director of General Education or a disbursing agent designated by him and approved by the State Board of Education and the Director of Vocational and Technical Education or a disbursing agent designated by him and approved by the State Board of Vocational Education shall give bond to the State of Arkansas as provided by law for other disbursing agents, conditioned for the faithful performance of their duties and the faithful accounting for all the school money of the state, of any
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county, or of any school district that may come into their hands.
(2) The bond shall be in a solvent surety company having a right to do business in the State of Arkansas and shall be approved by the State Board of Education.
(3) The premium on the bond shall be paid by the State Board of Education as one of the expenses of the board.
(g) The state shall furnish the directors with suitable offices."

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-11-103 is hereby amended to read as follows:
"6-11-103. Officers.
(a) The boards shall elect one (l) of its number chairman, one (l) vice chairman, and such other officers as the boards deem necessary to perfect its organization.
(b) The Director of the General Education Division shall act as ex officio Secretary of the State Board of Education without vote.
(c) The Director of the Vocational and Technical Division shall act as ex officio Secretary of the State Board of Vocational Education without vote."

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Annotated § 25-6-101 is hereby amended to read as follows:
"25-6-101. Purpose.
(a) The purpose and intent of this chapter is to divide the Department of Education into two (2) major divisions, the General Education Division and the Vocational and Technical Education Division, with each major division to be under the supervision and direction of a separate director.
(b) It is intended that all authority and responsibility of the State Board of Vocational Education be administered through the Vocational and Technical Education Division under the direction and supervision of the Director of Vocational and Technical Education, and that all authority and responsibility of the State Board of Education be administered through the General Education Division under the direction and supervision of the Director of General Education.
(c) It is further the purpose and intent of this chapter that the authority and responsibility of the State Board of Vocational Education and
the Vocational and Technical Education Division include general control and supervision of all programs of vocational, technical, and occupational education in secondary institutions. This authority shall apply to programs in state postsecondary vocational schools, area vocational high school centers, public schools, and in any other public education facility or institution now in existence or hereafter established in the state with the exception of technical colleges, community colleges, universities, and colleges."

SECTION 5. Arkansas Code Annotated § 25-6-102 is hereby amended to read as follows:
"25-6-102. Organization - Directors.
(a) The Department of Education shall consist of:
(1) The State Board of Education;
(2) The General Education Division under the direction and supervision of the Director of General Education;
(3) The State Board of Vocational Education;
(4) The Vocational and Technical Education Division under the direction and supervision of the Director of Vocational and Technical Education; and
(5) Any other divisions or subdivisions as presently exist within the Department of Education or as may be created by the State Board of Education and State Board of Vocational Education or as created by law and placed under the Department of Education.
(b) The State Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education shall continue to perform their powers and duties as prescribed by law.
(c) (1) The Director of General Education and the Director of Vocational and Technical Education shall be co-equal, and each shall be a member of the Governor's Cabinet.
(2) The Director of General Education shall perform all duties and exercise all powers relating to general education as may be granted by law.
(3) The Director of Vocational and Technical Education shall perform all duties and exercise all powers relating to vocational and
technical education as are vested in the Director of Vocational and Technical Education by law or by the State Board of Vocational Education."

SECTION 6. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 7. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 8. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the immediate effectiveness of this act is essential to the operation of the Department of Education. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
