SECTION 27. TRANSFER PROVISION - FOREIGN OFFICES. If at any time during the 1995-97 biennium, the Director determines that market conditions warrant, the Arkansas Industrial Development Commission is hereby authorized to transfer appropriation, after receiving the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, between any of the three Foreign Offices (European Trade, Far East Trade/Industrial Recruitment and Latin American Trade Development) in Section 3 of this Act for the purpose of responding to changes in the world markets.

SECTION 28. TRANSFER PROVISION. If at any time during the 1995-97 biennium, savings are accomplished in the appropriation provided for "European Trade", "Far East Trade/Industrial Recruitment", "Latin American Trade", and "Regular Salaries" in Section 3 of this Act, such appropriation savings may be transferred to the appropriations made for "Maintenance and General Operations" in Section 3 of this Act. 8 SECTION 30. TRANSFER PROVISION. After receiving approval from the 9 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Director of the Arkansas Industrial 10 Development Commission is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line 11 item appropriation authorized in Section 6 of this Act to any other line item 12 authorized in Section 6 of this Act and any line item appropriation 13 authorized in Section 4 of this Act to any other line item authorized in 14 Section 4 of this Act.

There is hereby established a pool of thirteen (13) positions entitled State Economic Developer III to be assigned to the Arkansas Industrial Development Commission which will be used to reclassify personnel from State Economic Developer I and/or State Economic Developer II. To obtain a position from the pool, the Arkansas Industrial Development Commission must seek a review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, obtain approval from the Office of Personnel Management and must surrender the position being reclassified to the pool. This will ensure that the total positions available to be filled does not exceed the number authorized in the Agency's appropriation Act.

32 SECTION 33. CARRY FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending 33 June 30, 1996, any unexpended appropriation provided for the Century Tube 34 Scholarship Program shall be carried forward and made available for the same 35 purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997.

2 SECTION 34. CARRY FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending 3 June 30, 1996, any unexpended appropriation provided in the line item 4 entitled "Train the Trainer Program" shall be carried forward and made 5 available for the same purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. 6

7 SECTION 35. SECTION 36. FOREIGN OFFICE OPERATIONS. The Arkansas Industrial 14 15 Development Office is hereby authorized to enter into contractual 16 arrangements with private and/or public companies, corporations or 17 organizations for the purpose of operating foreign offices. Payment for such 18 contractual arrangements for operations may be made from the special line 19 items established by legislative appropriation for the operation of foreign 20 offices. At such time as any of the foreign offices are being operated under 21 such a contractual arrangement, no Overseas Program personnel as authorized 22 by Arkansas Code 15-4-211 shall be employed concurrently with a contractual 23 arrangement with a company, corporation or organization. Arkansas Code 15-4-24 211 shall not be deemed restrictive in its language so as to preclude the use 25 of standard Professional Services Contracts for the operation of the foreign 26 offices and/or payment of such contracts from the special line items as 27 established by legislative appropriation for the operation of said foreign 28 offices.

29

30 SECTION 37. TRANSFER PROVISION - INDUSTRY TRAINING. If during either 31 year of the 1995-97 fiscal biennium, the Industry Training Division effects 32 savings in Item (06), Industry Training Program Equipment, of Section 23 of 33 this Act, such savings may be transferred to item (02), Extra Help or item 34 (05), Maintenance and General Operations, of Section 23 of this Act, after 35 obtaining approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. In addition, if

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any savings are effected in either year of the 1995-97 fiscal biennium in
 item (05), Maintenance and General Operations, of Section 23 of this Act,
 such savings may be transferred to item (06), Industry Training Program
 Equipment, of Section 23 of this Act, after obtaining approval of the Chief
 Fiscal Officer of the State.

7 SECTION 38. TRANSFER PROVISION - INDUSTRY TRAINING PROGRAM. During 8 either fiscal year of the 1995-97 biennium, any savings accomplished in line 9 item (02) of Section 23 of this Act, Extra Help, may be transferred to line 10 item (05) of Section 23 of this Act, Maintenance and General Operation.

SECTION 39. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

21

SECTION 40. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

31 SECTION 41. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and 32 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and 33 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 34

35 SECTION 42. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

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application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

5

6 SECTION 43. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 7 with this Act are hereby repealed.

8

9 SECTION 44. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by 10 the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of 11 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year 12 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to 13 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are 14 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the 15 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work 16 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential 17 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist 18 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 19 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after 20 July 1, 1995.
