For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 21-8-701 TO REQUIRE
8 STATEMENTS OF FINANCIAL INTERESTS FOR PUBLIC OFFICIALS TO
9 INCLUDE INCOME DERIVED FROM PERSONS WHO ARE REGISTERED
10 LOBBYISTS OR WHO EMPLOY REGISTERED LOBBYISTS; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "TO REQUIRE PUBLIC OFFICIALS_
14 STATEMENTS OF FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE TO
15 INCLUDE INCOME DERIVED FROM REGISTERED
16 LOBBYISTS."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-8-701(d)(2) is amended to read as
21 follows:

22 "(2)(A) Identification of each employer and of each other source of
23 income amounting to more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) annually received
24 by the person or his or her spouse in their own names, or by any other person
25 for the use or benefit of the public servant or his or her spouse, and a
26 brief description of the nature of the services for which the compensation
27 was received, and in addition thereto, shall identify each source of income
28 as described above of more than twelve thousand five hundred dollars
29 (\$12,500).

32 (B) Nothing in this subdivision (d)(2) shall be construed to
33 require the disclosure of individual items of income that constitute a
34 portion of the gross income of the business or profession from which the
35 public servant or his or her spouse derives income, except that individual

1 items of business or professional income shall be disclosed if the income is
2 derived from a person who is a registered lobbyist or from an employer who
3 compensates a person as a registered lobbyist or reimburses a registered
4 lobbyist for lobbying efforts on their behalf;"

6 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
7 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
8 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9

10 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
13 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14 act are declared to be severable.

15

16 SECTION 4 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
17 hereby repealed.
