8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-27-104 PERTAINING TO
9 ENGINEERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

11 Subtitle

12 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-27-104
13 PERTAINING TO ENGINEERS."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17 SECTION 1. *Arkansas Code 17-27-104 is amended to read as follows: "§*
18 *17-27-104. Construction.*

19 *The provisions of this chapter affirm the legal authority of an*
20 *engineer licensed under its provisions to provide consultation,*
21 *investigation, evaluation, planning, and design of buildings intended for*
22 *accommodation of equipment, vehicles, goods, and/or processes or other*
23 *utilitarian functions, with human occupancy including office space as*
24 *required for the support of these functions, provided the engineer is*
25 *practicing within his or her area of competency as defined by this chapter."*

26

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
28 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
29 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
35 act are declared to be severable.

2 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
3 hereby repealed.

4 *SECTION 5. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly
5 that it is necessary to clarify the authority of engineers licensed under the
6 engineering licensing law; that this act accomplishes the same; and that such
7 clarification should be accomplished as soon as possible. Therefore, an
8 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the
9 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
10 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.*
