For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING EXPENSES
 9 FOR THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION WHICH SHALL BE
 10 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
 11 BY ACT 74 OF 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

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"AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE
 COMMISSION SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
 20 Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission, to be payable from the Motor Vehicle
 21 Commission Fund, for operating expenses of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle
 22 Commission which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
 23 appropriated in Section 2 of Act 74 of 1993, the following:

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1 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 2 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 3 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 4 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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11 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 13 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 14 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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20 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
 21 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
 22 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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24 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
 25 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
 26 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
 27 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
 28 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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30 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
 31 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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33 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
 34 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for
 35 the operations of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission are, due to

1 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Motor Vehicle
2 Commission to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
3 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas
4 Motor Vehicle Commission to continue such services; and that a delay in the
5 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
6 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
7 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
8 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
9 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

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
