         SECTION 33. The Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology
 3
 4 is hereby authorized to provide special compensation to certain employees for
 5 each full pay period (80 hours) worked in a job which requires contact with
 6 inspection sites or emergency sites or other sites where exposure to
 7 potentially hazardous substances is possible. State and Federal law and
 8 statute mandate regulatory inspection to protect the environment and the
 9 health of the citizens of the State of Arkansas. It is further recognized
10 that many substances which may be encountered are suspected carcinogens
11 and/or mutagens and may create harmful health effects from either short-term
12 or long-term exposure.
13
14 This special pay is to compensate the employees for the increased risk of
15 personal injury.
16
17 Rate of pay will be five and one half percent (5-1/2^{2}) above regular
18 authorized pay or rate of pay. Payment will be controlled through personnel
19 actions by Administrative Services, Personnel Section. Rate of pay for
20 individuals who work less than a full pay period (80 hours) and/or transfer
21 to other work areas not defined above will not receive any enhanced rate of
22 pay for that or subsequent pay periods. This covers employees who may be
23 exposed to potentially hazardous substances during the daily performance of
24 their job duties.

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1 SECTION 34. There is hereby established a pool of twenty-three (23) 2 positions in the title of X338 Engineer, PE, grade 22. SECTION 36. (a) The Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (the Commission) shall employ a full time administrative hearing officer to perform such functions and duties as the Commission shall direct and in particular to advise the Commission on matters of law and procedure that may arise during the conduct of Commission duties and responsibilities as outlined in Ark. Code §8-1-203, §8-4-201, §8-4-202, §8-4-311, §8-5-205, §8-6-27 207 or as otherwise provided by law.

28 (b) The administrative hearing officer shall be selected and hired by the
29 Commission and shall be independent of and not an employee of the Department

SECTION 38. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

34 SECTION 39. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 35 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

SECTION 40. (a) For purposes of this section "motor vehicle" means every motor vehicle defined by Ark. Code 8-9-402. 9

(b) Due to the noise, air pollution and traffic congestion caused by 10 11 motor vehicle racing facilities, no motor vehicle racing facility may be 12 constructed in this state after passage of this act without the consent of at 13 least seventy-five percent (75%) of the property owners and seventy-five 14 percent (75%) of the adult residents within three (3) miles of the outside 15 boundary of the proposed facility. Such consent shall be accomplished by 16 signing petitions which shall be filed with the city clerk if the facility is 17 to be located within the boundaries of any city or town or with the county 18 clerk if the facility is to be located wholly or partially outside the 19 boundaries of any city or town. The petitions shall indicate the name, 20 residence address, or if a non-resident property owner, the address or legal 21 description of the property located within the three (3) mile area, and the 22 date of the signature. The petitions must be verified pursuant to Ark. Code 7-9-109. Signatures shall become invalid sixty (60) days after signing. 23

(c) It shall be the duty of the county clerk or city clerk, as the 24 case may be, to determine the sufficiency of the signatures. 25 26

SECTION 41. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and 27 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and 2.8 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 29 30

31 SECTION 42. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 32 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 33 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 34 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 35 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
