11 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

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SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - DEPARTMENT OF LABOR - OPERATIONS. There
20 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Labor, to be payable from the
21 Department of Labor Fund Account, for operating expenses of the Department of
22 Labor which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated
23 in Section 2 of Act 127 of 1993, the following:

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1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - DEPARTMENT OF LABOR - FEDERAL - OSHA AND
 2 MSHA. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Labor, to be
 3 payable from the federal funds, as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
 4 the State, for operating expenses which shall be supplemental and in addition
 5 to those funds appropriated in Section 4 of Act 127 of 1993, the following:

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18 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 19 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 21 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 30 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 31 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of the Department of Labor are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Labor to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Labor to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

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
