8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 24, CHAPTER 11,
9 SUBCHAPTER 1 TO ALLOW A MEMBER OF A POLICEMEN_S PENSION
10 AND RELIEF FUND TO PURCHASE CREDITED SERVICE FOR SERVICE
11 *WITH ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.*"

14 "AN ACT TO ALLOW A MEMBER OF A
15 POLICEMEN_S PENSION AND RELIEF FUND TO
16 PURCHASE CREDITED SERVICE FOR SERVICE
17 *WITH ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY.*"

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 24, Chapter 11, Subchapter 1 is amended
22 by adding the following new section:

23 "*24-11-104. Service in another municipality.*"

24 Any member of a municipal policemen_s pension and relief fund, under
25 this chapter, who has employment service with another municipality shall be
26 entitled to purchase credited service in the policemen_s pension and relief
27 fund. The credited service shall be equivalent to the amount of service he
28 or she had with the other municipal police department up to a maximum of two
29 (2) years of service. The member must contribute to the system an amount, as
30 the board of the policemen_s pension and relief fund shall determine,
31 equivalent to the member_s contribution and the employer contributions, plus
32 regular interest from the time of the service with the local police
33 department to the time of the credit purchase. "

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent

1 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
2 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3

4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
