# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1432

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 24, CHAPTER 11,  
SUBCHAPTER 1 TO ALLOW A MEMBER OF A POLICEMEN\_S PENSION  
AND RELIEF FUND TO PURCHASE CREDITED SERVICE FOR SERVICE  
WITH ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

"AN ACT TO ALLOW A MEMBER OF A  
POLICEMEN\_S PENSION AND RELIEF FUND TO  
PURCHASE CREDITED SERVICE FOR SERVICE  
WITH ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 24, Chapter 11, Subchapter 1 is amended  
by adding the following new section:

*"24-11-104. Service in another municipality.*

Any member of a municipal policemen\_s pension and relief fund, under  
this chapter, who has employment service with another municipality shall be  
entitled to purchase credited service in the policemen\_s pension and relief  
fund. The credited service shall be equivalent to the amount of service he  
or she had with the other municipal police department up to a maximum of two  
(2) years of service. The member must contribute to the system an amount, as  
the board of the policemen\_s pension and relief fund shall determine,  
equivalent to the member\_s contribution and the employer contributions, plus  
regular interest from the time of the service with the local police  
department to the time of the credit purchase. "

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent

1 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
2 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
8 act are declared to be severable.

10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
11 hereby repealed.
