17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 24-10-502 is amended to read as
20 follows:

21 "24-10-502. Military service.

22 (a) In the event a member who, while an employee, enters the armed
23 forces of the United States during any period of compulsory or voluntary
24 military service, the armed service actually served by him shall be credited
25 him as service under this subchapter. This shall be done only if he again
26 becomes an employee within a period of one (1) year from and after honorable
27 termination of the armed service actually served by him, and if he returns to
28 the system the amount, if any, he may have withdrawn therefrom at the time he
29 entered or while in the armed services, together with regular interest from
30 the date of withdrawal to the date of repayment.

31 (b) In any case of doubt as to the period of armed service to be so
32 credited a member, the board shall have final power to determine the period.

33 (c) During the period of armed service and until his return as an
34 employee, his contributions to the system shall be suspended, and any balance

1 remaining to his credit in the system shall be accumulated at regular
2 interest."

3 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
4 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
5 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

6
7 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 act are declared to be severable.

13 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
14 hereby repealed.

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 24-10-502 TO REQUIRE THAT A LOPFI MEMBER RECEIVE RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR VOLUNTARY MILITARY SERVICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

"TO REQUIRE THAT A LOPFI MEMBER RECEIVE RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR VOLUNTARY MILITARY SERVICE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 24-10-502 is amended to read as follows:

"24-10-502. Military service.

(a) In the event a member who, while an employee, enters the armed forces of the United States during any period of compulsory or voluntary military service, the armed service actually served by him shall be credited him as service under this subchapter. This shall be done only if he again becomes an employee within a period of one (1) year from and after honorable termination of the armed service actually served by him, and if he returns to the system the amount, if any, he may have withdrawn therefrom at the time he entered or while in the armed services, together with regular interest from the date of withdrawal to the date of repayment.

(b) In any case of doubt as to the period of armed service to be so

1 credited a member, the board shall have final power to determine the period.

2 (c) During the period of armed service and until his return as an
3 employee, his contributions to the system shall be suspended, and any balance
4 remaining to his credit in the system shall be accumulated at regular
5 interest."

6 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
7 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
8 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9

10 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14 act are declared to be severable.

16 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
17 hereby repealed.
