# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1473

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 27-32-112 TO PROVIDE THAT INSPECTION CERTIFICATES FOR MOTORCYCLES BE PLACED IN AN APPROPRIATE SPACE ON THE LICENSE PLATE; TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE TO REDESIGN THE MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION DECAL FOR MOTORCYCLES TO COMPLY WITH THIS REQUIREMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT INSPECTION CERTIFICATES FOR MOTORCYCLES BE PLACED IN AN APPROPRIATE SPACE ON THE LICENSE PLATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-32-112(d) is amended to read as follows:

"(d) At the conclusion of each inspection of a motor vehicle by the person performing the inspection, the appropriate inspection certificate shall be placed in the lower left hand portion of the front windshield on the driver's side in a place that shall not obstruct the vision of the driver, except that, upon the inspection of a motorcycle, the inspection certificate shall be placed in the appropriate space on the license plate."

SECTION 2. *The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police is authorized to make any necessary changes in the design of the motor vehicle safety inspection decals for motorcycles in order to comply with Arkansas Code § 27-32-112(d). The motor vehicle safety inspection decals for*

1 motorcycles shall be designed to fit within a space on the license plate  
2 designated for that purpose.

3       The Department shall make the design changes so to comply with these  
4 requirements effective with the issuance of inspection decals for the 1996  
5 calendar year.

7       SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

11       SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
12 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
13 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
14 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
15 act are declared to be severable.

17       SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
18 hereby repealed.
