HOUSE BILL 1481

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7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 8-6-609 TO REQUIRE THE
9 POLLUTION CONTROL AND ECOLOGY DEPARTMENT TO ISSUE AN
10 ANNUAL REPORT ON GRANTS MADE FROM THE SOLID WASTE
11 MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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14 Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE POLLUTION CONTROL
16 AND ECOLOGY DEPARTMENT TO ISSUE AN
17 ANNUAL REPORT ON GRANTS MADE FROM THE
18 SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING
19 FUND."

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-6-609 is amended to add the following new
24 subsection:

25 *"(d)(1) The Department shall prepare an annual progress report on
26 grant assistance made under this section. The report shall include the
27 amount of each grant, the purpose of the grant, how grant funds were expended
28 by the applicant, the results produced or the progress made on the project,
29 and revenues produced and tonnages of materials collected by the project.*

30 *(2) The report for each calendar year shall be filed by the first day
31 of July of the following year with the office of the Governor. The report
32 shall include information on grant recipients for a period of five (5) years
33 from the date of disbursement of funds by the Department.*

34 *(3) Regional Solid Waste Management Boards shall provide the
35 Department with a report summarizing progress in the project, expenditures*

1 from the grant award, tonnages of materials collected by the project and
2 revenues produced by the sale of materials collected. The report shall be
3 filed six (6) months after disbursement of funds and semi-annually for each
4 year thereafter. Failure by a Board to file the required reports shall
5 provide grounds for the Department to withhold disbursement of grant funds
6 for subsequent grant rounds."

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8 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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12 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16 act are declared to be severable.

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18 SECTION 4. The provisions of this act shall be in addition and
19 supplemental to all other laws of the state of Arkansas now in effect and
20 shall repeal only such laws or parts of laws as may be specifically in
21 conflict with this act.
