10 OR AGAINST ANY PERSON OR A BALLOT ISSUE WHILE ON DUTY; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT STATE EMPLOYEES FROM
15 CAMPAIGNING FOR OR AGAINST ANY PERSON OR
16 A BALLOT ISSUE WHILE ON DUTY."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. (a) No state employee shall while on duty attempt to
21 persuade any persons to vote for or against any candidate or ballot issue.

22 (b) The violation of this act constitutes a Class A misdemeanor.

24 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
25 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
26 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
29 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
30 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
31 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
32 act are declared to be severable.

34 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
35 hereby repealed.
