10 NONCONTRIBUTORY BENEFIT PLAN TO CONTRIBUTORY SERVICE; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "AN ACT TO ALLOW AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE
16 TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO CONVERT
17 SERVICE IN THE NONCONTRIBUTORY BENEFIT
18 PLAN TO CONTRIBUTORY SERVICE."

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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23 SECTION 1. (a) Any active member of the Teachers Retirement System
24 who voluntarily changed to the noncontributory benefit plan from the
25 contributory benefit plan may return to the contributory plan and convert
26 noncontributory service into contributory service by:

27 (1) Before July 1, 1996, making application with the Executive
28 Director of the Teachers Retirement System to return to the contributory
29 benefit plan and to convert noncontributory service to contributory service;
30 and

31 (2) Within five (5) years after making application, paying to the
32 Teachers Retirement System an amount equal to the member_s contributions that
33 would have been paid under the contributory benefit plan, plus interest at
34 the rate of six (6%) per annum from the dates the contributions would
35 normally have been received by the system to the date of payment.

1 (b) This section shall be supplemental to all other laws pertaining to
2 the Teachers Retirement System and shall not repeal any other law concerning
3 transfer of membership between the contributory and noncontributory benefit
4 plans of the Teachers Retirement System.

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6 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
7 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
8 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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10 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14 act are declared to be severable.

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
