## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
10 ADMINISTRATION - REVENUE SERVICES DIVISION WHICH SHALL BE  
11 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED  
12 BY ACT 931 OF 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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## Subtitle

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"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE  
AND ADMINISTRATION - REVENUE SERVICES  
DIVISION SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
22 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division, the  
23 following maximum number of regular employees which shall be supplemental and  
24 in addition to those positions authorized in Section 1 of Act 931 of 1993  
25 and whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
26 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or  
27 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
28 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
29 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
30 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
31 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
32 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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7       SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the

8 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division, to be

9 payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and

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27       SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - DATA PROCESSING. There is hereby

28 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue

29 Services, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for the

30 purchase of data processing by the Department of Finance and Administration -

32 those funds appropriated in Section 7 of Act 931 of 1993, the following:

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4 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - POSTAGE. There is hereby appropriated, to  
5 the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division, to  
6 be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for postage expenses of the  
7 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division which  
8 shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section  
9 ~~8 of Act 931 of 1993, the following:~~

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15 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
16 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
18 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
21 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
22 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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25 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
27 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
28 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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34 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the

1 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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3       SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
4 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
5 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
6 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
7 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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9       SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
10 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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12       SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
13 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for  
14 the operations of the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue  
15 Services Division are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the  
16 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division to  
17 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of  
18 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and  
19 Administration - Revenue Services Division to continue such services; and  
20 that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm  
21 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
22 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
23 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
24 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
25 passage and approval.

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
