# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1530

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## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 21-5-414 TO AUTHORIZE  
8 CONTRIBUTIONS BY THE STATE OF ARKANSAS TO PARTIALLY DEFRAY  
9 THE COST OF LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE FOR EACH EMPLOYEE OF  
10 THE STATE PARTICIPATING IN THE PLAN ADOPTED BY THE STATE  
11 EMPLOYEES INSURANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

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## Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CONTRIBUTIONS BY  
16 THE STATE OF ARKANSAS TO THE INSURANCE  
17 PLAN FOR STATE EMPLOYEES."

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-5-414 is amended to read as follows:  
23 "21-5-414. State contributions generally - Partial state contribution  
24 of employees' premiums.

25 (a) The State Employees Insurance Advisory Committee shall seek the  
26 advice of the Legislative Council and the Joint Interim Committee on  
27 Insurance and Commerce before additional contribution can be made.

28 (b) The State of Arkansas is authorized to make a monthly contribution  
29 up to but not to exceed the amount for the period indicated below to  
30 partially defray the cost of life and health insurance for each employee of  
31 the state participating in the plan adopted by the State Employees Insurance  
32 Advisory Committee.

35 (c) The Governor may, by executive order, consolidate all health

1 insurance plans affecting state employees, excluding those affecting  
2 employees of institutions of higher education and uniformed employees of the  
3 Department of Arkansas State Police covered by the Department of Arkansas  
4 State Police health plan, into one (1) plan or allow other governmental plans  
5 to become a part of the state employees insurance plan which is established  
6 by § 21-5-401 et seq. All reserves and assets of any affected plan shall be  
7 transferred to the receiving plan."

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9           SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
10 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
11 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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13           SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
14 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
15 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
16 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
17 act are declared to be severable.

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19           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
20 hereby repealed.

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
