## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT AGREEMENTS TO SHARE A  
8 CUSTOMER-BANK COMMUNICATION TERMINAL SHALL NOT PROHIBIT  
9 A BANK FROM CHARGING A CBCT USAGE FEE; AND FOR OTHER  
10 PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

12 "TO PROVIDE THAT AGREEMENTS TO SHARE A  
13 CUSTOMER-BANK COMMUNICATION TERMINAL  
14 SHALL NOT PROHIBIT A BANK FROM CHARGING  
15 A CBCT USAGE FEE"

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 *SECTION 1. An agreement to share a "customer-bank communication  
20 terminal" as defined by Arkansas Code Annotated §23-32-1301, shall not  
21 prohibit, limit, or restrict the right of a bank or other financial  
22 institution from charging a "CBCT" usage fee. For purposes of this act,  
23 usage fee is a fee charged by a CBCT owner on transactions by a holder of a  
24 foreign bank card. For purposes of this act, a foreign bank card is a card  
25 eligible for use in a CBCT and which card is not issued by the CBCT owner.  
26 The usage fee shall not exceed two dollars (\$2.00) or two percent (2%) of the  
27 gross amount of the transaction, whichever is less, and may only be imposed  
28 if imposition of the fee is disclosed at a time and in a manner that allows a  
29 user to terminate or cancel the transaction without incurring the usage fee.*

30

31 *SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
32 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
33 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*

2        SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
6 act are declared to be severable.

7

8        SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
9 hereby repealed.
