## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ANY PERSON OPERATING A PICKUP TRUCK OR  
9 FLATBED TRUCK OR TOWING A FLATBED TRAILER ON A PUBLIC  
10 STREET OR HIGHWAY WHEN A CHILD *NINE (9)* YEARS OF AGE OR  
11 YOUNGER IS OCCUPYING THE OPEN BED OF THE TRUCK OR TRAILER;  
12 TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 27-35-104 BY STRIKING  
13 ONE EXCEPTION TO THE PROHIBITION AGAINST PERSONS RIDING ON  
14 ANY PORTION OF A VEHICLE NOT INTENDED FOR PASSENGER USE;  
15 TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §§ 27-34-103 AND -104  
16 RELATING TO CHILD PASSENGER PROTECTION; AND FOR OTHER  
17 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

20 "TO PROHIBIT PERSONS OPERATING PICKUP  
21 TRUCKS OR FLATBED TRUCKS OR TRAILERS  
22 WHEN CHILDREN AGE 9 OR YOUNGER ARE  
23 OCCUPYING THE OPEN TRUCK OR TRAILER BED"

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26

27 SECTION 1. (a) No person shall operate an open bed pickup truck or an  
28 open flatbed truck or shall tow an open flatbed trailer on a public street or  
29 highway when a child *nine (9)* years of age or younger is occupying the bed or  
30 cargo area of the truck or trailer.

31 (b) A violation of this section is punishable by a fine of not less  
32 than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200).

33 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply when the person is  
34 operating or towing the vehicle in an emergency *or participating in a parade*  
35 *authorized by a city or county.*

2 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated § 27-34-104(a) is amended to read  
3 as follows:

4 "(a) Every driver who transports a child under the age of five (5)  
5 years in a passenger automobile, van, or pickup truck shall provide, while  
6 the motor vehicle is in motion and operated on a public road, street, or  
7 highway of this state, for the protection of the child by properly placing,  
8 maintaining, and securing the child in a child passenger safety seat system  
9 meeting applicable federal motor vehicle safety standards in effect on  
10 August 1, 1983."

11

12 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Annotated § 27-34-103(a) is amended to read  
13 as follows:

14 "(a) Any person who violates this chapter shall, upon conviction, be  
15 fined not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than two hundred  
16 dollars (\$200)."

17

18 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Annotated § 27-35-104 is amended to read as  
19 follows:

20 "27-35-104. Riding in spaces not for passengers.

21 (a) No person shall ride on any vehicle or upon any portion of the  
22 vehicle, including the cargo area, that is not designed or intended for the  
23 use of passengers.

24 (b) This section shall not apply to any individual employee engaged in  
25 the necessary discharge of a duty, either for an employer or for private  
26 purposes."

27

28 SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
29 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
30 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31

32 SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

2

3 SECTION 7. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
4 hereby repealed.
