## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -  
10 GENERAL EDUCATION DIVISION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING  
11 JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
15 - GENERAL EDUCATION DIVISION  
16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - MATH AND SCIENCE SCHOOL. There is  
21 hereby established for the Department of Education - General Education  
22 Division - Math and Science School for the 1995-97 biennium, the following  
23 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
24 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
25 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
26 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
27 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
28 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
29 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
30 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
31 or its successor.

9 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - MATH AND SCIENCE SCHOOL. There is hereby  
10 appropriated, to the Department of Education - General Education Division -  
11 Math and Science School, to be payable from the Public School Fund, solely  
12 from monies transferred from the Educational Excellence Trust Fund, for  
13 personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Education -  
14 General Education Division - Math and Science School for the biennial period  
15 ending June 30, 1997, the following:

1           SECTION 3. *EXTRA HELP.* *There is hereby authorized for the Department*  
2 *of Education - General Education Division - Math and Science School, for the*  
3 *1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary*  
4 *employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated*  
5 *herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when*  
6 *needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform*  
7 *Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor or this act for the*  
8 *appropriate classification.*

9

10           SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

20           SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
22 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
23 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

29           SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
30 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
31 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33           SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

6

7 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
8 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
9 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period;  
10 that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the  
11 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are  
12 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the  
13 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work  
14 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
15 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
16 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
17 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after  
18 July 1, 1995.
