8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 17-81-312 PERTAINING TO
9 CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CHIROPRACTORS; AND
10 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 17-81-
14 312 PERTAINING TO CONTINUING EDUCATION
15 REQUIREMENTS FOR CHIROPRACTORS."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-81-312 is amended to read as follows:
20 "17-81-312. Renewal - Education requirement.

21 (a) The board shall not renew the license of any person actively
22 engaged in practice within the State of Arkansas unless the person presents
23 to the board evidence of attendance, during the preceding twelve (12) months,
24 at: (1) An approved educational session or sessions of not less than
25 twenty-four (24) hours' duration conducted by an approved chiropractic
26 institution of learning, or by some association approved by the board for the
27 teaching of scientific courses pertaining to the profession; or
28 (2) An educational course conducted by the board.

29 (b)(1) The board may waive the requirement upon being presented a
30 certificate from the doctor in charge that the license holder was physically
31 unable on account of sickness or injury, or upon a showing that the license
32 holder was in military service, when the course was conducted within this
33 state during the preceding twelve (12) months.

34 (2) The board may waive the requirement for any other valid
35 reason.

1 (c) The presentation of a fraudulent or forged evidence of attendance
2 at an educational session shall be a cause for suspension or revocation of
3 the holder's license."

5 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
6 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
7 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

8

9 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.

14

15 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16 hereby repealed.
