## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES FOR  
9 THE MID-SOUTH COMMUNITY COLLEGE WHICH SHALL BE  
10 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED  
11 BY ACT 696 OF 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE MID-SOUTH COMMUNITY  
15 COLLEGE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

16

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
20 Mid-South Community College, to be payable from the Mid-South Technical  
21 College Fund, for personal services of the Mid-South Community College which  
22 shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section  
23 3 of Act 696 of 1993, the following:

31 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
32 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
33 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
34 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

1 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure  
2 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
3 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
4 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
5 with in disbursement of said funds.

7         SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
9 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
10 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15

16         SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
17 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
18 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

19

20         SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
22 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
23 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
24 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

25

26         SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
27 with this Act are hereby repealed.

28

29         SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
30 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for the  
31 operations of the Mid-South Community College are, due to unforeseen  
32 circumstances, insufficient for the Mid-South Community College to continue  
33 to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act  
34 will provide the necessary monies for the Mid-South Community College to  
35 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act

1 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of  
2 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared  
3 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
4 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and  
5 after the date of its passage and approval.
