## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-12-103 (b) TO REQUIRE A  
8 PAWBROKER TO RECORD THE DRIVER\_S LICENSE NUMBER, PERSONAL  
9 IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, OR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF THE  
10 PERSON FROM WHOM PROPERTY IS RECEIVED; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE A PAWBROKER TO  
14 RECORD THE DRIVER\_S LICENSE NUMBER,  
15 PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, OR  
16 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF THE PERSON  
17 FROM WHOM PROPERTY IS RECEIVED."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-103 (b) is amended to read as follows:  
23 "(b) The records required under subsection (a) shall include a  
24 detailed record of each and every transaction including the type of  
25 identification displayed by the person from whom the property was received;  
26 the name, address, race, sex, height, weight, and date of birth of the person  
27 from whom the property was received; the driver\_s license number, personal  
28 identification number issued under § 27-16-85 or the number from some other  
29 form of photograph identification of the person from whom the property was  
30 received; a description of each item pawned, including, but not limited to,  
31 identifying numbers or serial numbers. The records shall be maintained on the  
32 following form:

13 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
14 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
15 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

16  
17 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
20 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
21 act are declared to be severable.

22  
23 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
24 hereby repealed.
