For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ANY TEACHER WHO RETIRED DURING
9 1994 WITH TWENTY-NINE YEARS OF SERVICE SHALL BEGINNING
10 JULY 1, 1995, RECEIVE FULL RETIREMENT BENEFITS; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "ANY TEACHER WHO RETIRED DURING 1994
15 WITH TWENTY-NINE YEARS OF SERVICE SHALL
16 BEGINNING JULY 1, 1995, RECEIVE FULL
17 RETIREMENT BENEFITS."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20

21 SECTION 1. Beginning July 1, 1995, any teacher who retired under the
22 Teacher Retirement System in 1994 with twenty-nine (29) years accredited
23 service in the system shall receive full benefits without reduction.

25 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
26 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
27 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28

29 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
30 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
31 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
32 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
33 act are declared to be severable.

34

35 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.

2 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the
3 General Assembly that teachers who retired in 1994 with twenty-nine (29)
4 years of service should begin receiving full benefits on the first day of the
5 next fiscal year and that unless this emergency clause is adopted this act
6 will probably not go into effect until after the first day of the next fiscal
7 year. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being
8 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
9 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
