## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE CERTAIN RESPONSIBILITIES REGARDING  
8 THE STORAGE OF LOADED FIREARMS AND TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL  
9 OFFENSE OF NEGLIGENTLY STORING A LOADED FIREARM AND  
10 PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREFOR; TO REQUIRE FIREARM DEALERS  
11 TO FURNISH A FIREARM LOCKING DEVICE AND WARNING AT THE  
12 TIME OF SALE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "TO PRESCRIBE RESPONSIBILITIES REGARDING  
16 STORAGE OF LOADED FIREARMS AND REQUIRE  
17 FIREARM DEALERS TO FURNISH A FIREARM  
18 LOCKING DEVICE AND WARNING AT TIME OF  
19 SALE"

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23

24 SECTION 1. (a) It is unlawful for any person to store or keep any  
25 loaded firearm on premises he owns or has under his control if he knows that  
26 a minor under the age of sixteen (16) years is likely to gain access to the  
27 loaded firearm without the permission of the person or the minor's parent or  
28 guardian unless the person stores or keeps the loaded firearm securely locked  
29 with a trigger lock, gun lock or gun locking device appropriate for such  
30 firearm, stores or keeps the loaded firearm in a securely locked container,  
31 stores or keeps the loaded firearm in a location *believed to be secure*, or  
32 *stores or keeps the loaded firearm legally* on his person or in a readily  
33 retrievable location as if carried on his person while present on the  
34 premises.

35 (b)(1) A person who violates the provisions of subsection (a) of this

1 section is guilty of negligently storing a firearm.

2                   (2) Negligently storing a firearm is a Class A misdemeanor;  
3 unless, as a result of the negligent storage of the firearm, a minor under  
4 the age of sixteen (16) years obtains possession of the firearm and causes  
5 injury or death to himself or another person, in which case negligently  
6 storing a firearm is a Class D felony.

7

8                 SECTION 2. (a) Each person, firm or corporation which engages in the  
9 sale of firearms shall, simultaneously with the sale of any firearm, provide  
10 to the purchaser thereof a trigger lock, gun lock or gun locking device  
11 appropriate for such firearm.

12               (b) Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of  
13 subsection (a) of this section shall be subject to a civil penalty in such an  
14 amount as a court of competent jurisdiction may prescribe, but not to exceed  
15 five hundred dollars (\$500) for the first violation and not less than one  
16 thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each subsequent violation.

18               SECTION 3. (a) Each person, firm or corporation which engages in the  
19 sale of firearms shall, simultaneously with the sale of any firearm, provide  
20 to the purchaser a printed warning in conspicuous bold type which shall  
21 state: "NEGLIGENTLY STORING A LOADED FIREARM IS A CRIMINAL OFFENSE AND MAY  
22 RESULT IN IMPRISONMENT AND FINE".

23               (b) Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of  
24 subsection (a) of this section shall be subject to a civil penalty in such an  
25 amount as a court of competent jurisdiction may prescribe, but not to exceed  
26 five hundred dollars (\$500) for the first violation and not less than one  
27 thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each subsequent violation.

29               SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33               SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
2 act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
5 hereby repealed.
