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7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE RED RIVER
9 TECHNICAL COLLEGE FOR RENOVATING, REMODELING AND RE-
10 ROOFING A CLASSROOM BUILDING TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SCIENCE
11 LABS AND RENOVATING AND REMODELING VARIOUS BUILDINGS TO
12 MEET REQUIREMENTS OF THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT;
13 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "AN ACT FOR THE RED RIVER TECHNICAL
17 COLLEGE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
18 APPROPRIATION."

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Red
23 River Technical College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or
24 its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

25 (A) For renovating, remodeling and re-roofing a classroom building to
26 provide additional science labs and renovating and remodeling various
27 buildings to meet requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act, the
28 sum of \$638,000.

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30 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
31 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
32 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
33 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
34 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
35 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or

1 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
2 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
3 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
4 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
5 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
6 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this Act.

7 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
8 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
9 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
10 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
11 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
12 disbursement of any funds provided by this Act unless specifically provided
13 otherwise by law.

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15 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
17 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
18 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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24 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
25 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
26 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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28 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
29 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
30 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
31 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
32 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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34 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
35 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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2 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
3 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
4 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period;
5 that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the
6 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
7 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
8 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
9 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
10 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
11 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
12 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
13 July 1, 1995.
