9       "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE ARKANSAS STATE POLICE OFFICERS  
10      DEFERRED OPTION PLAN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## **Subtitle**

12       "TO ESTABLISH THE ARKANSAS STATE POLICE  
13       OFFICERS DEFERRED OPTION PLAN"

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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17       SECTION 1. Deferred retirement option plan.

18       (a) In lieu of terminating employment and accepting a service  
19      retirement pension, any state police officer who is a member of the Arkansas  
20      State Police Retirement System and who has not less than thirty (30) years of  
21      credited service and who is eligible to receive a service retirement pension  
22      may elect to participate in the Arkansas State Police Officers Deferred  
23      Option Plan and defer the receipts of benefits in accordance with the  
24      provisions of this act, provided the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas State  
25      Police Retirement System approves the participation in the plan.

26       (b) For purposes of this act, credited service shall include service  
27      credit recognized pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §24-3-301.

28       (c) The duration of participation in the Arkansas State Police  
29      Officers Deferred Option Plan for active state police officers shall not  
30      exceed five (5) years. At the conclusion of a member's participation in the  
31      Arkansas State Police Officers Deferred Option Plan, the member shall  
32      terminate employment with the Arkansas State Police, and shall start  
33      receiving the member's accrued monthly retirement benefit from the Arkansas  
34      State Police Retirement System.

35       (d) When a member begins participation in the Arkansas State Police

1 *Officers Deferred Option Plan, the employer contributions shall continue to*  
2 *be paid. State contributions for employees who elect the Arkansas State*  
3 *Police Officers Deferred Option Plan shall be credited to the Arkansas State*  
4 *Police Retirement System. The monthly retirement benefits that would have*  
5 *been payable had the member elected to cease employment and receive a service*  
6 *retirement shall be paid into the Arkansas State Police Officers Deferred*  
7 *Option Plan Account.*

8           (e)(1) The member's monthly retirement benefit shall not change,  
9 unless the plan receives a benefit increase.

10           (2) A member who participates in this plan shall earn interest  
11 at a rate of two percentage points below the rate of return of the investment  
12 portfolio of the Arkansas State Police Retirement System, but no less than  
13 the actuarial assumed interest rate as certified by the actuary. The  
14 interest shall be credited to the individual account balance of the member on  
15 an annual basis.

16           (f) A participant in the plan shall receive at the option of the  
17 participant, a lump sum payment from the account equal to the payments to the  
18 account, or a true annuity based upon the account of the participant or may  
19 elect any other method of payment if approved by the Board of Trustees of the  
20 Arkansas State Police Retirement System.

21           (g) If the participant dies during the period of participation in the  
22 plan, a lump sum payment equal to the account balance of the participant  
23 shall be paid to the participant's survivor.

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25           SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
26 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
27 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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29           SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
30 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
31 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
32 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
33 act are declared to be severable.

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35           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
