8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 24-10-102 TO DEFINE
9 NORMAL RETIREMENT AGE UNDER THE LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE
10 RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO ALLOW MEMBERS TO RETIRE WITH TWENTY-
11 FIVE (25) YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICE REGARDLESS OF THEIR
12 AGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-10-102(17) is amended to read as
23 follows:

24 "(17) Normal retirement age means the younger of the following ages:

25 (A) Age fifty-five (55) years if the member has at least twenty
26 (20) years of credited service;

27 (B) Age sixty (60) years if the member has fewer than twenty
28 (20) years of credited service;

29 (C) The age the member has completed twenty-five (25) years of
30 credited service;"

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

HOUSE BILL

1 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
4 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
5 act are declared to be severable.

7 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8 hereby repealed.
