For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT AMENDING ARK. CODE § 8-9-502 TO AUTHORIZE THE
8 DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF POLLUTION CONTROL AND
9 ECOLOGY TO APPOINT ADDITIONAL MEMBERS TO THE ARKANSAS
10 NEWSPAPER RECYCLING ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPT.
14 OF PC & E TO APPOINT ADDITIONAL MEMBERS
15 TO THE ARKANSAS NEWSPAPER RECYCLING
16 ADVISORY COMMITTEE."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 8-9-502 is hereby amended to read
21 as follows:

22 "8-9-502. Members.

23 The Director of the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology shall
24 appoint an Arkansas Newspaper Recycling Advisory Committee consisting of:

25 (1) The Chief of the Marketing Division of the Department of Pollution
26 Control and Ecology, or his designee;

27 (2) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Press Association, or his
28 designee;

29 (3) At least six (6) members representing the Arkansas newspaper
30 industry and newsprint manufacturers doing business in Arkansas; provided,
31 however, that these members shall be selected from a list of names of
32 potential members to be provided by the President of the Board of Directors
33 of the Arkansas Press Association."

2 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
3 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
4 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5

6 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
7 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
8 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
9 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10 act are declared to be severable.

11

12 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
13 hereby repealed.
