8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE STATE POLICE WHO

SECTION 1. Any person who retired under the State Police Retirement System in 1989 and who has since served at least four (4) consecutive years as an elected county sheriff may purchase his prior county service as credited service under the Public Employees Retirement System. The purchase of such service shall be accomplished by the retiree paying all employee and employer contributions that would have been paid had he been a member of the Public Employees Retirement System during the county service with interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum compounded annually from the date the county service began to the date payment is received by the Public Employees Retirement System. Hereafter the county shall make contributions on behalf of the person hereinabove described in the same manner and to the same extent it does on other county employees.

HOUSE BILL

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
2 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
3 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
