## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-35-108(e)(1) RELATING TO  
9 VEHICLES HAULING SOLID WASTES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

12 "AMEND CODE RELATING TO VEHICLES HAULING  
13 SOLID WASTES."

14

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-35-108(e)(1) is amended to read as  
18 follows:

19 "(e)(1) Every vehicle hauling solid waste, in addition to complying  
20 with the size and weight laws of this state, must meet the following  
21 requirements:

22 (A) Any vehicle hauling between seventeen yards (17 yds.) and  
23 twenty-three yards (23 yds.) of compacted solid waste shall have two (2)  
24 axles with brakes attached to the chassis;

25 (B) Any vehicle hauling twenty-four yards (24 yds.) or more of  
26 compacted solid waste shall have four (4) axles with brakes attached to the  
27 chassis;

28 (C) Tractor and trailer combinations hauling no more than fifty yards  
29 (50 yds.) of compacted solid waste shall have six (6) axles with brakes;

30 (D) No vehicle shall haul more than fifty yards (50 yds.) of compacted  
31 solid waste unless the vehicle has a trailer attached;

32 (E) Six-axle tractor and trailer combinations may haul in open-top  
33 containers or trailers up to eighty yards (80 yds.) of noncompacted solid  
34 waste, excluding rock, sand, concrete, sludge, and articles which may be  
35 placed in a compacted position; and

1           (F) All vehicles hauling solid waste must have yardage placards  
2 attached to both sides of the body or container, except that roll-off  
3 containers with a capacity of no more than twenty-one yards (21 yds.) are not  
4 required to display the yardage placards."

5

6           SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
7 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
8 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9

10          SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
14 act are declared to be severable.

15

16          SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
17 hereby repealed.
