7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-91-201 AND 17-93-301 TO
8 PROVIDE THAT THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE
9 SHALL SERVE AS AN *EX OFFICIO NON-VOTING MEMBER* OF THE
10 ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY AND THE ARKANSAS STATE
11 MEDICAL BOARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE ATTORNEY
16 GENERAL OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE SHALL
17 SERVE AS AN *EX OFFICIO NON-VOTING MEMBER*

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-91-201 is amended by adding the following
26 new subsection:

27 "(e) In addition to the other members of the Arkansas State Board of
28 Pharmacy, the Attorney General or his or her designee shall serve as *an ex*
29 *officio non-voting* member of the board. The designee must be an employee of
30 the Attorney General."

31

32 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-93-301 is amended by adding the following
33 new subsection:

34 "(g) In addition to the other members of the Arkansas State Medical
35 Board, the Attorney General or his or her designee shall serve as *an ex*

1 *officio non-voting* member of the board. The designee must be an employee of
2 the Attorney General."

3

4 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
5 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
6 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7

8 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12 act are declared to be severable.

13

14 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
15 hereby repealed.
