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7 SECTION 23. The funds appropriated in Item (06) of Section 7 of this 8 Act, for the purpose of purchasing equipment or advanced technology for 9 laboratory instruction and demonstration projects related to the teaching of 10 science and mathematics shall be used to defray up to fifty percent (50%) of 11 the total cost of the proposed equipment; provided, however, that the amount 12 contributed by the Department of Education - General Education Division may 13 not exceed \$5,000 per project.

By January 1, 1994, and each year thereafter, the Department of Education shall compile and present to the Governor, State Board of Education and the Joint Interim Committee on Education a report outlining the status of implementing each of the provisions of the Public School Student Services Act by the various school districts.

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29 SECTION 30. The balance of the funds appropriated in Item (01) of 30 Section 9 which remain on June 30, 1996, may be carried forward and used for 31 the same purposes during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. 32

33 SECTION 31. The Southeast Arkansas Community Action Corporation is 34 hereby authorized and urged to solicit grants, donations, federal funds, and 35 any other funds available for the construction of the multi-purpose adult

3 SECTION 32. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 4 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 6 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

13 SECTION 33. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 15 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 16 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

22 SECTION 34. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and 23 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and 24 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 25

SECTION 35. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

32 SECTION *36*. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 33 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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35 SECTION 37. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by

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1	the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
2	Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
3	period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to
4	the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
5	provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
6	delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
7	irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
8	governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
9	and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10	peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
11	July 1, 1995.
