8 "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF UNCODIFIED ACT 1288
9 OF 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

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12 "TO AMEND SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF UNCODIFIED
13 ACT 1288 OF 1993."

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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17 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Uncodified Act 1288 of 1993 is hereby amended
18 to read as follows:

19 "SECTION 3. (a) The Arkansas Pygmalion Commission on Nontraditional
20 Education shall be composed of *eighteen (18)* members to be appointed in the
21 manner and to represent various interests as follows:

22 (1) One (1) member representing classroom teachers to be
23 recommended by the Arkansas Education Association and appointed by the
24 Governor;

25 (2) One (1) member representing school district superintendents
26 to be recommended by the Arkansas Association of Education Administrators and
27 appointed by the Governor;

28 (3) *One (1) member representing local school boards to be*
29 *recommended by the Arkansas School Boards Association and appointed by the*
30 *Governor;*

31 (4) Two (2) members representing school principals with
32 alternative education experience to be recommended by the Arkansas
33 Association of Education Administrators and appointed by the Governor;

34 (5) One (1) member representing the Department of Health and
35 appointed by the Governor;

1 (6) One (1) member representing the Department of Human Services
2 and appointed by the Governor;

3 (7) One (1) member representing the General Education Division
4 of the Department of Education and appointed by the Governor;

5 (8) One (1) member representing the Vocational and Technical
6 Education Division of the Department of Education and appointed by the
7 Governor;

8 (9) One (1) member representing the Department of Higher
9 Education and appointed by the Governor;

10 (10) One (1) member of the House of Representatives and the
11 Joint Interim Committee on Education or the Joint Committee on Children and
12 Youth to be appointed by the Speaker of the House;

13 (11) One (1) member of the Senate and the Joint Interim
14 Committee on Education or the Joint Committee on Children and Youth to be
15 appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

16 (12) One (1) member representing the judicial system to be
17 appointed by the Governor;

18 (13) One (1) member representing students with learning
19 disabilities or Attention Deficit Disorder to be appointed by the Governor;

20 (14) Two (2) members representing physicians and psychologists
21 who specialize in treating children and adolescents to be recommended by the
22 Chief of Staff of Arkansas Children's Hospital and appointed by the Governor;

23 (15) One (1) member representing parents to be recommended by the
24 Arkansas Congress of Parents and Teachers Association and appointed by the
25 Governor; and

26 (16) One (1) member at-large to be appointed by the Governor.

27 (b) The commission shall expire on June 30, 1999, unless the
28 commission is continued by further act of the Arkansas General Assembly."

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30 SECTION 2. Section 4 of Uncodified Act 1288 of 1993 is hereby amended
31 to read as follows:

32 "SECTION 4. (a) The commission shall select one of its members to
33 serve as chairman.

34 (b) The Director of the General Education Division shall serve as a
35 disbursing officer of any funds received by the commission.

1 (c) By July 1, 1996, and each year thereafter until the commission
2 expires, the commission shall submit a report containing recommendations for
3 alternative and nontraditional methods for meeting the educational needs of
4 all Arkansas children and for funding these recommendations, to the Governor,
5 the Joint Interim Committees on Education and Children and Youth, and the
6 Department of Education."

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8 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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12 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
16 act are declared to be severable.

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18 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
19 hereby repealed.
