HOUSE BILL 1710

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE MAXIMUM SALARY FOR THE DREW
COUNTY DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE MAXIMUM SALARY
FOR THE DREW COUNTY DEPUTY PROSECUTING
ATTORNEYS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Retroactive to January 1, 1995, the Prosecuting Attorney of the Tenth Judicial Circuit is entitled to appoint one or more deputy prosecuting attorneys for Drew County, whose combined salaries shall not exceed twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) per annum; provided however, the payment of the salaries shall be subject to the appropriation of the necessary funds by the Quorum Court of Drew County. The salaries shall be paid in monthly installments. In addition to the salaries, the Quorum Court may appropriate funds for contingent expenses of deputy prosecuting attorneys serving Drew County.

SECTION 2. The following obsolete and uncodified acts are repealed:

- (a) Act 207 of 1967;
- (b) Act 403 of 1969;
- (c) Act 84 of 1975.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

1 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

9 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.

12 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the
13 General Assembly that there has been an increase in the rate of crime in the
14 state and that in order to curb this rise in the crime rate and to promote
15 and accelerate the orderly administration of criminal justice, it is
16 necessary that this act become effective immediately. Therefore, an
17 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the
18 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
19 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
