HOUSE BILL 1712

Subtitle

"TO REPEAL THE ARKANSAS LAW REGARDING
THE REFERENDUM ON A HOTEL AND RESTAURANT
TAX."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas code § 26-75-602(d) is repealed.

21 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
22 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
23 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

25 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
26 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
27 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
28 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
29 act are declared to be severable.

31 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
32 hereby repealed.

34 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the
35 General Assembly that there is urgent need to clarify current law relating to

1 the method by which a hotel and restaurant tax shall be subject to referendum
2 and that the provisions of this act are designed to accomplish this purpose
3 and are immediately needed. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to
4 exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
5 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
6 after its passage and approval.
