HOUSE BILL 1764

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT AMENDING ARK. CODE § 12-61-108 TO PROVIDE THAT OFFICERS ASSIGNED TO THE AIR NATIONAL GUARD IN THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT COLONEL *OR ABOVE* SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT AS A DEPUTY ADJUTANT GENERAL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"TO AMEND A.C.A. § 12-61-108 TO PROVIDE FOR ELIGIBILITY OF LIEUTENANT COLONELS *OR ABOVE* IN THE AIR NATIONAL GUARD AS A DEPUTY ADJUTANT GENERAL."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 12-61-108(d) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(d) To be eligible for appointment as a Deputy Adjutant General for Air, the officer must be assigned to the Air National Guard in the rank of lieutenant colonel, *or above*, federally recognized."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
