11 "AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE TERMINATION PROVISIONS OF
12 SUBCHAPTER 14 OF CHAPTER 52 OF TITLE 26 OF ARKANSAS CODE;
13 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

17 "AN ACT TO CLARIFY AND TERMINATE
18 SUBCHAPTER 14 OF CHAPTER 52 OF TITLE 26
19 OF ARKANSAS CODE."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22

23 SECTION 1. Subchapter 14 of Chapter 52 of Title 26 of the Arkansas
24 Code, Arkansas Code §26-52-1401 through §26-52-1406, contains inconsistent
25 termination provisions, and in order to prevent litigation and violation of
26 federal provisions, is hereby terminated effective June 30, 1995.

28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
29 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
30 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31

32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act,
5 specifically Subchapter 14 of Chapter 52 of Title 26 of the Arkansas Code,
6 are hereby repealed.

7

8 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
9 Assembly that inconsistent termination provisions regarding provider taxes
10 exist in the current codification of Subchapter 14 of Chapter 52 of Title 26
11 of the Arkansas Code, which may provoke litigation and violate federal
12 provisions, and such provisions should be terminated. Therefore, an
13 emergency is declared to exist and, this act, being necessary for the
14 immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in
15 full force and effect from and after June 30, 1995.
