8 CODE § 7-6-102 TO REQUIRE INDEPENDENT CANDIDATES FOR
9 MUNICIPAL OFFICES TO FILE NOMINATING PETITIONS AND
10 POLITICAL PRACTICE PLEDGES BY TWELVE O'CLOCK NOON ON THE
11 DATE OF THE FILING DEADLINE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-42-206(b) is amended to read as follows:
23 "(b)(1) Any person desiring to become an independent candidate for
24 municipal office in cities and towns with the mayor-council form of
25 government shall, not more than eighty (80) days nor less than sixty (60)
26 days prior to the general election by twelve o'clock noon, file with the
27 county board of election commissioners their petition of nomination in
28 substantially the following forms:

29 (for all candidates except aldermen in cities of the first and second
30 class)

31 PETITION OF NOMINATION

32 TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS

33 We the undersigned qualified electors of the city (town) of,
34 Arkansas, being in number not less than ten (10) nor more than fifty (50), do
35 hereby petition that the name of be placed on the ballot for the

1 office of at the next election of municipal officials in 19... .
2 (for all candidates for aldermen in cities of the first and second
3 class)

4 PETITION OF NOMINATION

5 TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS

6 We the undersigned qualified electors of Ward of the city of
7 , Arkansas, being in number not less than ten (10) nor more than
8 fifty (50), do hereby petition that the name of be placed on the
9 ballot for the office of Alderman, Ward, position, of the next
10 election of municipal officials in 19... .

11 NAME ADDRESS VOTING PRECINCT

13 (2) Independent candidates for municipal office shall file a political
14 practice pledge no later than sixty (60) days prior to the date of the
15 general election by twelve o'clock noon."

16

17 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-6-102(a)(3) is amended to read as
18 follows:

19 "(3) Independent candidates for municipal office shall file their
20 political practices pledges with the county clerk of the county not less than
21 sixty (60) calendar days before the general election by twelve o'clock noon."

22

23 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
24 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
25 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

26

27 SECTION 4. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
28 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
29 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
30 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
31 act are declared to be severable.

32

33 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
34 hereby repealed.
