HOUSE BILL 1786

8 *"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING BODY OF CITIES OF THE*
9 *SECOND CLASS AND INCORPORATED TOWNS TO PROVIDE BY*
10 *ORDINANCE FOR EXPENDITURES NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND*
11 *DOLLARS (\$1,000) ANNUALLY FOR INCIDENTALS FOR EMPLOYEES*
12 *AND OTHER INDIVIDUALS PROVIDING SERVICES DIRECTLY OR*
13 *INDIRECTLY FOR THE CITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."*

Subtitle

15 *"TO AUTHORIZE CITIES OF THE SECOND CLASS*
16 *AND INCORPORATED TOWNS TO PROVIDE BY*
17 *ORDINANCE FOR EXPENDING UP TO ONE*
18 *THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) ANNUALLY FOR*
19 *INCIDENTALS FOR EMPLOYEES AND OTHER*
20 *PERSONS PROVIDING SERVICES TO THE CITY."*

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. The governing body of every second class city and
26 incorporated town may by ordinance authorize the expenditure of city funds in
27 an amount not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per year for
28 incidentals for employees or other individuals providing services directly or
29 indirectly for the city. Such incidentals include but are not limited to
30 expenditures for visiting dignitaries and officials, to boost morale, and to
31 express sympathy or concern for employees or citizens of the city. The
32 ordinances shall be valid only for the fiscal year during which enacted.

33

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

1 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.
