8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 231 OF 1995, WHICH PROVIDES
9 APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE GAME AND FISH
10 COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997,
11 TO REALLOCATE REGULAR SALARY POSITIONS; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

14 Subtitle

15 "AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 231 OF 1995 WHICH
16 PROVIDES APPROPRIATION FOR THE
17 OPERATIONS OF THE GAME AND FISH
18 COMMISSION."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Item (12) of Section 1 of Act 231 of 1995 is hereby amended
23 to read as follows:

32 SECTION 2. Item (15) of Section 1 of Act 231 of 1995 is hereby amended
33 to read as follows:

5 SECTION 3. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
6 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
7 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
8

9 SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
10 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
11 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
12 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
13 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
14

15 SECTION 5. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
16 with this Act are hereby repealed.
17

18 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
19 Eightieth General Assembly, that the positions authorized for the 1995-97
20 biennium for the Game and Fish Commission as found in Act 231 of 1995 would
21 not provide for the proper administration of the duties of the Commission;
22 that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the
23 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
24 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
25 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
26 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
27 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
28 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
29 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
30 July 1, 1995.
