HOUSE BILL 1809

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE BOARD OF BARBER EXAMINERS
TO ESTABLISH FEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE BOARD OF
BARBER EXAMINERS TO ESTABLISH FEES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The State Board of Barber Examiners shall by regulation establish reasonable registration fees, renewal fees, examination fees and such other fees as it deems necessary and appropriate to fulfill its duties.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-18-302 is amended to read as follows:

"17-18-302. Qualifications of applicants.

Any person shall be qualified to receive a certificate of registration to practice as a registered barber who:

(1) Is qualified under the provisions of subchapters 1, 2, and 3 of this chapter;

(2) Is of good moral character and temperate habits;

(3) Has passed a satisfactory examination conducted by the board to determine his or her fitness to practice barbering and furnishes a diploma showing graduation from a grammar school or its equivalent as determined by an examination conducted by the board;

(4) Is at least sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) years of age and of good moral character and temperate habits;

(5) Has received training approved by the appropriate licensing authorities; and

1 (6) Passes a satisfactory examination conducted by the board to
2 determine his or her fitness to practice as a registered barber."

4 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 17-18-307(c)(2) is amended to read as
5 follows:

6 "(2) Any registered barber who retires from the practice of barbering
7 and fails to keep his registration certificate renewed for not more than
8 three (3) years may renew his certificate of registration upon payment of the
9 required restoration fee. If the time elapsed is more than three (3) years,
10 he or she must take and pass the required examination and pay the examination
11 fee as set forth by the board."

13 SECTION 4. Subsection (a) of Section 17-18-208 of the Arkansas Code is
14 hereby repealed.

16 SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
17 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
18 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

19

20 SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
24 act are declared to be severable.

26 SECTION 7. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
27 hereby repealed.
