## 7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND 7-4-109(e) TO PROHIBIT RELATIVES WITHIN  
9 THE SECOND DEGREE OF CONSANGUINITY OF A CANDIDATE IN THE  
10 CURRENT ELECTION FROM SERVING AS ELECTION JUDGES, CLERKS  
11 OR OFFICERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## 13 Subtitle

14 "TO PROHIBIT RELATIVES OF CANDIDATES  
15 FROM SERVING AS ELECTION JUDGES, CLERKS  
16 OR OFFICERS"

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-4-109(e) is amended to read as follows:  
21 "(e) No person may serve as an election judge, clerk, or officer if  
22 related within the second degree of consanguinity to any candidate running  
23 for office in the current election if the candidate has opposition, unless  
24 the opposing candidates agree that the relative may serve as an election  
25 judge, clerk, or officer."

26

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
28 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
29 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
35 act are declared to be severable.

2           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
3 hereby repealed.
