14 CONCERNING CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR
15 ARCHITECTS."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-14-203 is amended by adding the following
20 new subsection (e) to read as follows:

21 "(e) The Arkansas State Board of Architects may adopt regulations
22 setting minimum standards of continuing education to insure that all
23 registered architects remain informed of those technical and professional
24 subjects which the Board deems appropriate to professional architectural
25 practice. The Board may by rules and regulations describe the methods by
26 which such standards may be satisfied, and may provide that failure to
27 satisfy such minimum standards shall be grounds for nonrenewal of an
28 architect's certificate of registration."

29

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
31 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
32 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
