HOUSE BILL 1890

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For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 17-44-102 TO STANDARDIZE
8 ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES AND PENALTIES BETWEEN SECTIONS OF
9 THE STATE_S PUBLIC HEALTH CODE BY ADDING CIVIL PENALTY
10 AUTHORITY TO THE ARKANSAS WATERWORKS OPERATORS ACT; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "TO STANDARDIZE PUBLIC HEALTH
15 ENFORCEMENT BY ADDING CIVIL PENALTY

17 OPERATORS ACT."

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 17-44-102 is amended to read as
23 follows:

24 "17-44-102. Penalties.

25 (a) Any person or persons, representing a firm, corporation,
26 municipality, or other political authority who violates any of the provisions
27 of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction
28 thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars
29 (\$100) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or by imprisonment in the
30 county jail for not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and
31 imprisonment. Each day during which a violation continues shall be a
32 separate offense.

33 (b) Every firm, person, or corporation who violates this act or any of
34 the rules or regulations issued or promulgated by the State Board of Health,
35 or who violates any condition of a license, permit, certificate, or any other

1 type of registration issued by the board may be assessed a civil penalty by
2 the board. The penalty shall not exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for
3 each violation. Each day of a continuing violation may be deemed a separate
4 violation for purposes of penalty assessments.

5 (c) All fines collected under this section shall be deposited in the
6 State Treasury and credited to the Waterworks Operators Licensing Fund to be
7 used to defray the costs of administering this section.

8 (d) Subject to such rules and regulations as may be implemented by the
9 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the disbursing officer of the Department
10 of Health is authorized to transfer all unexpended funds relative to fines
11 collected under this subsection, as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
12 the State, to be carried forward and made available for expenditures for the
13 same purpose for any following fiscal year."

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15 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
16 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
17 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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19 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
20 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
21 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
22 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
23 act are declared to be severable.

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25 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
26 hereby repealed.

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
