# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1899

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CUSTOM CROP HARVESTERS AND CUSTOM APPLICATORS SHALL HAVE A LIEN AGAINST THE CROP; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

"TO PROVIDE THAT CUSTOM CROP HARVESTERS AND CUSTOM APPLICATORS SHALL HAVE A LIEN AGAINST THE CROP."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Every person who harvests agricultural crops belonging to another shall be entitled to a lien against those crops for payment of the cost of harvesting. *Every person who sprays fertilizer, pesticides, or herbicides as a custom applicator on the agricultural crops or lands belonging to another shall be entitled to a lien for the payment of the custom application and that lien shall be against those crops sprayed or the crops next harvested after the land is sprayed. The lien provided for in this act shall be filed in the manner prescribed for materialmen's liens under Ark. Code 18-44-117.*

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
5 hereby repealed.
