# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1915

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT CONCERNING CONFLICT OF INTERESTS OF THE DIRECTOR,  
EXECUTIVE SECRETARY, OR CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF A  
STATE BOARD OR COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

"AN ACT CONCERNING CONFLICT OF INTERESTS  
OF THE DIRECTOR, EXECUTIVE SECRETARY, OR  
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF A STATE  
BOARD OR COMMISSION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a)(1) It is a conflict of interest for a person employed as the director, executive secretary, or chief administrative officer of a state board or commission that issues licenses to engage in a business, occupation, or profession to hold any financial interest in a business regulated by the board or commission.

(2) No person, who has a conflict of interest under this section, shall be employed as the director, executive secretary, or chief administrative officer of a state board or commission.

(3) Any director, executive secretary, or chief administrative officer who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class B misdemeanor.

(b) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a director, executive secretary, or chief administrative officer from holding a license issued by the state board or commission.

1           SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
2 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
3 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5           SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
9 act are declared to be severable.

11           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
12 hereby repealed.
