HOUSE BILL 1916

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 19-4-1602 TO ADD THE
9 ARKANSAS REHABILITATION ASSOCIATION TO THE LIST OF PAYROLL
10 DEDUCTIONS ALLOWED FOR STATE EMPLOYEES; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO ALLOW THE ARKANSAS REHABILITATION
15 ASSOCIATION TO THE LIST OF PAYROLL
16 DEDUCTIONS ALLOWED FOR STATE EMPLOYEES."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-1602 is amended to read as follows:
21 "19-4-1602. Payroll deductions.

22 (a) Deductions from the payrolls of state employees, both regular and
23 extra help, shall be permitted only for the following purposes:

24 (1) Withholding taxes;

25 (2) Social security contributions;

26 (3) Contributions to any state retirement system or approved
27 plan of deferred compensation;

28 (4) Group hospital, medical, and life insurance deductions.

29 However, any payroll deductions through the Arkansas state mechanized payroll
30 system for state employees for coverages other than the state authorized plan
31 shall be approved by the State Employees Insurance Advisory Committee;

32 (5) Payments to state employees' credit unions;

33 (6) Value of maintenance perquisites;

34 (7) Payment of union dues, when requested in writing by state
35 employees;

1 (8) Purchase of United States Government savings bonds;

2 (9) Arkansas State Employees' Association, Inc., dues, when
3 requested in writing by state employees;

4 (10) *Fees for participation in the State Employees Benefit*
5 *Corporation, when requested in writing by the State employees;*

6 (11) Contributions to the major federated fund-raising
7 organization, when authorized by state employees;

8 (12) Arkansas State Police Association dues, when authorized in
9 writing by state employees;

10 (13) Fraternal Order of Police dues, when requested in writing
11 by state employees;

12 (14) Arkansas Rehabilitation Association dues, when authorized
13 in writing by state employees; and

14 (15) For such other purposes as are specifically authorized by
15 law but not enumerated in this subsection.

16 (b) Deductions as are authorized by this section shall be made in
17 compliance with rules, regulations, and procedures established by the Chief
18 Fiscal Officer of the State."

19

20 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
21 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
22 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

23

24 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
25 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
26 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
27 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
28 act are declared to be severable.

29

30 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
31 hereby repealed.
